Armii Krajowej 51, entered into the register of entrepreneurs of the National Court Register under KRS number 0000048716, whose registration files are kept by the Katowice-Wschód District Court in Katowice, 8th Commercial Division of the National Court Register, share capital: PLN 5,747,632.12 paid in full, NIP (Tax Identification Number): 6340126246, REGON (Business Registry Number): 270641528.
2. Using the newsletter service requires you to have Internet access and an e-mail address. However, it is not necessary to meet any specific technical requirements apart from having a standard operating system and a standard web browser.
3. The e-mail address must be provided in order to subscribe to the newsletter. Your e-mail address will only be used to send you the newsletter.
4. After subscribing to the newsletter, you will receive information about published articles, interviews, videos, etc., especially focusing on the activities of FAMUR SA. The information included in the newsletter may constitute commercial information within the meaning of Article 2 of the Act of 18 July 2002 on Providing Services by Electronic Means, which may concern both FAMUR SA and its partners.
5. Newsletter messages are sent occasionally and do not follow a predetermined schedule.
6. You can unsubscribe from our newsletter at any time by clicking the appropriate link at the end of each newsletter message.

8. Your personal data are controlled by FAMUR SA with its registered office in Katowice (postal code: 40-698) at ul. Armii Krajowej 51.

10. Your personal data shall be processed on the basis of your consent (Art. 6 (1)(a) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council 2016).
11. The provision of data is voluntary, but necessary for the implementation of the newsletter service.
12. Your personal data will not be processed by automated means, including in the form of profiling.
13. Your personal data will be processed until you withdraw your consent.

14. Consent to the processing of personal data may be withdrawn at any time by e-mail at iod@famur.com.pl. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of the consent before its withdrawal.
15. Your personal data will also be deleted if the Administrator decides to cease the provision of the newsletter.
16. You have the right to request access to, rectify, limit the processing of, delete and object to the processing of your personal data as well as the right to transfer your personal data.
17. Entities providing IT and interactive marketing services may be the recipients of your personal data.
18. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
